- (1) Admission process for different UG Courses will be done strictly based on **merit** and general conditions as contained in Notification issued by Dept. of Higher Education (CS Branch), Govt. of West Bengal bearing No. 354 – Edn (CS)/10M-95/14 dated 02/06/2023 will be complied with in letter and spirit;
- (2) Students who have passed H.S. or other equivalent 10+2 Examinations during the years **2023, 2022 and 2021** may apply for admission;
- (3) Entire process of admission will be done **online**. At no point of time during the process of online admission any person including the applicant will be required to or allowed to come to the College in person for any purpose whatsoever. **No printed Application Form** or Prospectus will be issued from the College Office. All concerned are requested to follow the College web-site and College Online Admission Portal on a regular basis for important updates;
- (4) Entire process of online admission will be **cost-free** from the end of the College
- (5) Before the commencement of admission for a particular phase, serial number in the Final Merit Panel of eligible candidates for that particular phase will be notified in College Online Admission Portal. For the sake of benefits of applicants / aspirants **SMS** will be delivered to the eligible candidates in their mobile number (registered at the time of filing up of Admission Form). Eligible candidates are to strictly follow the time schedule. No request for admission will be entertained after the scheduled time. The College will not be responsible for non-delivery of SMS;
- (6) Nobody will be allowed to visit, in person or via any representative, any person in the College for any matter relating to online admission of students in different course offered by the College;
- (7) Any **query or correspondence** relating to this online admission including request for correction in filled in form after the publication of provisional merit panel can only be made via email to admission@ggmc.ac.in. Any claim or correspondence must be supported by relevant documents attached with the email;
- (8) **Payment** by successful candidates who will be willing to get himself / herself admitted in any course / programme offered by the College must follow the

procedure adopted by the College. College will not receive any cash in the College Cash Counter;

(9) All **testimonials** are required to be uploaded online during application. Physical verification of uploaded documents will be done as per schedule to be notified later on. Admission will be cancelled / rejected if the uploaded documents are found to be fake / false and not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted online;

(10) One candidate may apply for more than one courses/programmes. In that case **multiple applications** may be done using the same Registration Credential which will be generated when the applicant first uses this College's Online Admission Portal;

STEPS TO BE FOLLOWED

Steps of Application for any course / programme and Payment of Admission Fees, if applicable will include:

Step 1: Go to College Web-site: www.ggmc.ac.in or directly to College Online Admission Portal link <https://ggmcadmission.collegeadmission.org.in/>;

Step 2: Get ready with your own Mobile Number and e-mail ID (This mobile number and email ID will be used for various purposes in future like online University Examinations Form Fill up, Students' Scholarships, entry of the particulars of the students in banglaruchchashiksha portal (<https://banglaruchchashiksha.wb.gov.in/>) and the like;

Step 3: Register yourself by submitting some basic information following instructions and guidelines stated in the online admission portal;

Step 4: Get ready with scanned 'Recent Colour Passport Size Photo' (5 – 80 KB) & 'Signature' (5 – 50 KB) of the applicant (in .JPG/JPEG). Upload these as per instructions;

Step 5: Get ready with scanned testimonials in .pdf format only. Size of each testimonial must be within 200 KB. Scanned from Original documents will only be valid. Scanned from xerox copy / photocopy will not be accepted and if it is found that scanning is done from xerox copy / photocopy the whole application process of the candidate may be subject to cancellation summarily without showing any cause. Upload these documents as per instructions:

- (i) Admit Card / Certificate of Madhyamik Pariksha (MP);
- (ii) Admit Card of Higher Secondary (H.S.) or equivalent Examinations;
- (iii) Marksheet of Higher Secondary (H.S.) or equivalent Examinations;
- (iv) Caste Certificate issued by Competent Authority, if applicable;
- (v) AADHAR Card;
- (vi) EWS Certificate issued by Competent Authority, if applicable;
- (vi) Any other document, if required.

Step 6: Submit the Form / Forms as per instructions;

Step 7: Take Printout of the successfully submitted Form / Forms;

Step 8: Pay Admission Fees online, if applicable.

(2) In case of Board/Council other than W.B.C.H.S.E., a candidate shall have to pass in five [four, where applicable] recognized subjects of full marks not being less than 100 out of which one will be English;

(3) Marks obtained in top five subjects shall be considered to ascertain the aggregate marks of a candidate passing the examination under grade system. Also, for candidates passing H.S. (10+2) Examination from the West Bengal Council of Higher

Secondary Education under old system, marks obtained in top five subjects will be considered to determine the aggregate marks;

(4) Marks obtained in Environmental Studies as a compulsory subject in the H.S. (10+2) Examination conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent will not be taken into account for calculation of the aggregate marks in top five subjects for the purpose of admission.



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MERIT POINT CALCULATION

(A) Merit Point Calculation for BA (H/H&R) Single Major Course (Like Honours Subjects)

Merit Point = $X+Y$

X = 10 percent of marks in aggregate in the 10+2 level exam taking 5 best marks among all the subjects excluding the marks of Environmental Studies.

Y = percentage of marks in applied subject as Single Major Course. If that subject is not studied, the percentage of marks of one subject as indicated in the table below will be considered.

Single Major Subject	Percentage of marks in applied subject as Major (Y)

Political Science	Best marks in the language subjects
History	History

Note that if more than one candidate scores same merit point, preference will be given to higher Y. If more than one candidate has same score in $X+Y$, preference will be given to higher score in previous examination.

(B) Merit Point Calculation for Multidisciplinary Programme:

Only aggregate will be considered.
